

## **City of Tacoma Tacoma Venues & Events Special Event Road Closure Notice**

Closing the road during this event is required for the greatest public safety. Efforts will be made to minimize the impact to your residence or business. Event coordinators are required to instruct participants to follow all applicable City, State and Federal laws. Access to private driveways, parking lots/garages, sidewalks, walkways and/or alley ways may be delayed during the event; emergency vehicles will always have access to roads. The City's **Special Events Office** provides public notice of anticipated impacts to their neighborhoods as a part of the permitting process.
